If you would like to access these additional pages, you need to become a "member" - simply send your e-mail address to me (steve.amos@blueyonder.co.uk) and once I've admitted you, the website software will send you a generated user name and password. This area, and the pages within it, are password protected from the rest of the world - only members can access these pages.

At this stage we have

- the Church Directory as a download and as viewable pages

- On-Line@9 documents

There are some automatic facilities that we are not encouraging you to use such as internal members e-mail (folk are unlikely to want a second mailbox to check), but we will only be able to explore these once we go live - it will be a learning experience for us all!
